The Constable reviewed the duties of the Precinct One Constable's Office including patrol, serving warrants, and introduced the Command Staff.

6126 Abington Way House under Construction

Homeowner Timothy Beasley was accompanied by his Attorney. Bill introduced the Board. The homeowner reviewed the issue about the Design Review Committee's rejection of the plan review based on a third story and non-conformance with the neighborhood harmony. The original "third story" was revised to make it an uninhabited mechanical or unfinished space. Concerning the harmony and conformance comments, the homeowner felt as though that there were numerous examples in Section 5 that had architectural finishes with similar features.

Following the resident's response the President raised the question of whether any other houses had all of the various finishes. The Resident replied that they thought that some of the houses had more than one architectural feature and that a "wavier" has occurred by allowing other houses to be approved and constructed. Since the building is under construction and there has already been a delay of one (1) month due to the COH permitting issues, the owner wanted to get a resolution at this Board Meeting.

It was further discussed about whether the Board and Owner will further work together to resolve the third story and the height of the house issue. The owner has had a discussion with the builder concerning making modifications to soften the appearance. With no motions from any of the Board Members, the letter from the Design Review Committee will stand. The Owner indicated that they would proceed with their construction.

By a show of hands the majority of the Board Members believe that the design of the house has a "third story." Darlene Wayt made the suggestion that this matter be discussed at the next General Membership Meeting.

Jaycee Park CIP F-000758 Update

At a February 4, 2015 meeting, hosted by Ellen Cohen at the request of Jack Valinski, Lisa Johnson, the Parks Program Manager requested a letter, signed by Bill, on behalf of the SNC-14, endorsing a plan to upgrade the Jaycee Park lighting by prioritizing the ball field lighting including the security lights on the ball field light poles.

At the February 11 SNC-14 meeting, Pete provided the letter, Bill signed it and Darlene emailed it the next day to Johnson, Cohen and cc'd the SNC-14 Exective Committee and Delegates. Originals were delivered to Johnson's and Cohen's offices.



Report for 2/24/2015 Board of Directors Meeting
Lorraine Cherry

1. West 11th Street Park:

- a. Lorraine Cherry and Darlene Wayt met with organizers of the upcoming "Run the Grove" 5K fun run on April 18 to discuss how Friends of West 11th Street Park can contribute to the race. We will be helping to publicize and will liaise with the Parks Department about mowing schedules prior to the event. We will also have an informational table at the TMNA Spring Fling to be held at the park after the event, and will offer nature tours of the park.
- b. We have asked the Houston Parks Board for estimates on continuing trail work, to include (1) remediation of the access radial trail that enters the park near the kiosk and (2) cutting back undergrowth on some of the original trails to restore their full 8-foot width.
- Bryce Street proposed park: I spoke with the architectural firm that has been working on this
 project. They are currently securing "right of entry" permissions from the city, and estimate that the
 project will be completed by summer 2015. The hookup of the hike and bike trail from south of 11th
 St. to north of 11th St. is nearing completion.
- Southwaste Disposal: The permit application to expand the facility is on hold, at the request of Southwaste. A second permit application to perform odor-abating improvements at the current facility is pending.
- 4. **Items requiring action from the board:** Organizers of the TMNA fun run/Spring Fling event asked if TMCC would be interested in having a table at this event.
