- Secretary's Report for July 28, 2015
 - o A motion was made to approve the amended minutes by Darlene Wayt.
 - o The motion Seconded by Forrest Andrews.
 - The motion was approved by a show of hands.
- Treasurer's Report Paige Ochterbeck reviewed the report
 - o A motion was made by Gary Nordstrom to approve the Treasurer's Report.
 - The motion Seconded by Forrest Andrews.
 - The motion was approved by a show of hands.

Committee Reports

- Activities The Annual Volunteer appreciation dinner was a success. Snow is ordered for the SnowFest scheduled for December 5th.
- Beautification There were questions concerning the sprinklers in the esplanades.
- Block Captains There is a new Block Captain on Foxwood. Forrest volunteered to be a Block Captain on Lindyann.
- Design Review Committee (DRC) There were approvals for new houses at 6206 Hurst, 6414
 Lindyann and 1610 Droxford.
- Deed Restriction Enforcement
 - The Board was contacted by a representative of the ATF as a Type 1 (Dealer of Firearms) license was issued in July 2011 to Mr. Michael Moore to operate a firearms business at 1019 W. T.C. Jester. Mr. Moore leases the residence from Ms. Sylvia Munson who was in attendance at tonight's meeting.
 - o It was the understanding of the Board that the representative was trying to determine whether the deed restrictions had been changed allowing businesses to be operated from a residence and whether the Board had previously "approved" the firearms business. It is the understanding of the President and the Secretary that there has been no correspondence between the ATF and the Board; and that the TMCC Board Minutes do not have any mention of the licensing.

Committee Reports Continued

- Deed Restriction Enforcement
 - Peter Davies made the Motion that a copy of the Section 6 deed restrictions be sent to the ATF representative. The motion was seconded by Darlene Wayt and approved by a show of hands.
 - Leslie Hillendahl made the motion that a public records request regarding the history of the licensing be made to the ATF which was seconded by Gary Nordstrom. By a show of hands the motion was passed, with the Secretary being instructed to draft a request to be signed by the President and sent to the ATF.
- Environmental Affairs- Lorraine Cherry and Darlene Wayt
 - West 11th Street Park:
 - Fundraising to pay for the last planned trail construction project will begin soon.
 This is for the radial trail that enters the park at the kiosk on Shelterwood and runs west to connect with the ½-mile loop trail.
 - An educational program has been initiated to try to mitigate the growing problem of off-leash dogs in both of our neighborhood parks. Park users who see violations of the leash law are being encouraged to file a complaint with the 3-1-1 system.
 - Southwaste Disposal: Final approval of Southwaste's request to expand their operation has been tabled until they can demonstrate successful mitigation of their odor problem over a six (6) month period. Residents are being encouraged to continue filing odor complaints.
 - Bryce Street Park: TIRZ 5 (which is funding the project) reports that they finally have obtained "right of entry" from the city and are now trying to coordinate their project with Public Works' redo of the chemical treatment station. No new completion date estimated at this time.
 - Jaycee Park
 - o Portable Toilets
 - Darlene made a motion that the Board authorizes her to act on behalf of the TMCC to provide the necessary paperwork required by the COH, including allocating additional funds, not to exceed \$750, to make up any shortfalls from donations.
 - o Peter Davies seconded this motion.
 - By a show of hands the motion was approved.
 - Splash Pad Repairs
 - Board Members met with representatives of the Houston Parks Board concerning the proposed repairs of the splash pad, including the contractor. Work is to be completed sometime in November 2015.

- Jaycee Park
 - o Ball field Lighting
 - TMCC obtained a copy of the COH permitted set of drawings for the ball field lighting replacement which are posted on the TMCC and SNC-14 websites.
 - Following review of the drawings, it was observed that there were some issues that need to be addressed including protecting the existing planting, irrigation system and providing a point of contact for the COH during construction. These comments will be forwarded to the COH Project and Program Manager by means of a letter generated by the SNC-14
- Environmental Affairs
 - Bryce Street Chemical Feed Station The COH has posted the construction information sign on West 11th Street in front of the facility.
 - West 11th Street Blocked Sidewalks There was a report that the COH had posted yellow violation signs along the north side of West 11th Street between Shelterwood and Bryce Streets.

 - Plan to Include Hollypark in Proposed Patrol Area


