Info received on 3-22-16 from Duncan Elliott, COH Project Manager: The contractor replaced the irrigation lines. HPARD has been notified and an inspection has been requested. As soon as the irrigation system passes an HPARD inspection, the water will be turned back on to the park.

The contractor is currently working on the electrical connection to the park, we are working out an issue with existing underground utility lines on the corner of Seamist. We expect the electrical work to take another 2 weeks.

After the electrical service has been installed, irrspected, and made operational, the contractor will restore the sod, repair the cracked sidewalk, and complete any unfinished items on the tennis court shelter.

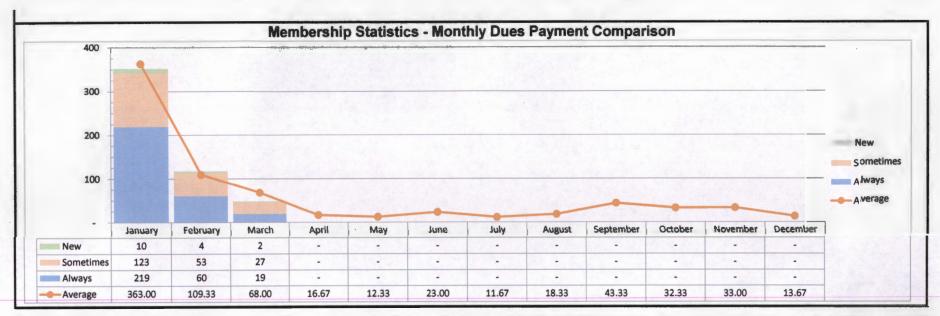
