- Environmental Affairs Report (Darlene Wayt)
 - Trees for Houston will trim and mulch the bottle brush trees that are on Ella Blvd. in front of Sinclair on 11-9-16.
 - o Friends of Jaycee Park
 - Payless Port-a-Jons has been paid to have to the chemical toilet units in the park from 12/6/16 to 12/6/17, with TMCC check #1419 for \$2,208.30, no price increase in 3 years.
 - Friends of Jaycee Park
 - A check for Mitchell Insurance (formerly Schmerler Insurance), is needed to renew HPARD-mandated insurance for the units, which is estimated to be around \$1,000. Darlene will be working on submitting the required paperwork during the next two weeks to HPARD by mid-November.
 - Pete continues to work with Houston Parks Board to resolve the splash pad's surface problems – failed caulk, exposed nails when the caulk fails and poor drainage.
 - West 11th Street Park (Lorraine Cherry) via e-mail
 - With the generous assistance provided by TMCC, we were able to move ahead and complete the 2016 trail repair and maintenance project at West 11th Street Park. Eleven areas of the trail were repaired with additional decomposed granite, the edges of the main trail were sprayed with herbicide to control poison ivy, and the main trail was cut back to its original width. For next year, we hope to be able to complete some additional trail construction to make outside access into the park easier.
 - We are moving ahead with our annual volunteer day at the park on Saturday, October 29, starting at 8:30 a.m. Much of the overgrowth from the summer season has already been removed, and volunteers will be completing that as well as installing 4 inches of new mulch on the main bed for weed/invasive control.
 - Friends of West 11th Street Park sent a letter thanking TMCC for their support.
 - Bryce Street Chemical Feed Stations Residents have continued to notice a foul stench emanating from the plant and loud noise related to the blowers. Joe Hanek with COH PWE is supposed to contact TMCC representatives concerning the final walk through which has not been scheduled at this time.


