Bryce Chemical Feed Station

Per Traci Elsner of MPT Cohen's office via an email dated 5-18-17:

The Contractor constructed the air filtering system in accordance with the contract. The system has been performing as designed. However, there has been inconsistent performance due to fluctuations in the material in the system. A City Operator has to visit the site every day to check levels and make adjustments as needed to maintain performance. The City has been evaluating the system for the past few months. The City has been working on the design of a remote sensing system to better monitor the odor levels. These improvements will help with the operations of the facility. The City is still preparing the documents required to implement this solution. As soon as the City has the timing determined, all interested parties will be notified. A final walk through will occur after the new monitoring system is in place.
