Location: Rainbow Lodge Rescheduled from Oct 31, 2017

Board Meeting began at 7:05 PM with Quorum requirements being met. (See Attached Sign-In Sheet)

Guest Speakers

Howard Moon expressed his concern that the Timbergram, by including information about a sitting HISD trustee who was running for re-election, was perceived as endorsing the particular candidate. The board clarified that the TMCC Board does not endorse or support any candidates and that the Timbergram publishes brief biographies of guest speakers that are submitted by the guest speakers.

Mr. Moon also reminisced about a previous Deed Restriction issue about a residence running a business out of their house and how they resolved it.

A group of Sec. 6 residents spoke at the beginning of the meeting. (See sign-in sheet.) Certain areas of Sec. 6 flooded during Hurricane Harvey. The residents want to re-build, however the City of Houston considers the residences as substantially damaged, and their finished floor elevation will have to be constructed at least 4-5 feet above grade.

The main issues are that houses in Section 6 are limited to one (1) story and there is no prescribed height restriction. After discussion, Peter Davies made a motion:

That the TMCC Board approve an amount of not to exceed \$5,000.00 to engage an attorney, specializing in Deed Restriction Issues, to provide an opinion of the options available for owners, to determine if a existing subsection of Timbergrove Manor can create its own section, with its own deed restrictions; and whether a harmony and conformity clause would be violated with the proposed increase in the elevation; and whether there are any legal precedents whereby "extenuating circumstances" serve as an exception to existing deed restrictions such that owners can disregard deed restrictions. Darlene Wayt seconded the motion. Following a discussion the Board voted unanimously to pass the motion.

Secretary's Reports - The Board reviewed the corrected 9.7.17 and 9.26.17 minutes. Darlene made the motion to approve the 9.27.17 minutes which was seconded by Leslie Hillendahl. Darlene also made the motion to approve the 9.26.27 minutes with Kirk Guy seconding the motion.

Treasurer's Report - Leslie Hillendahl made the motion to approve the report which was seconded by Peter Davies and was approved by a show of hands.

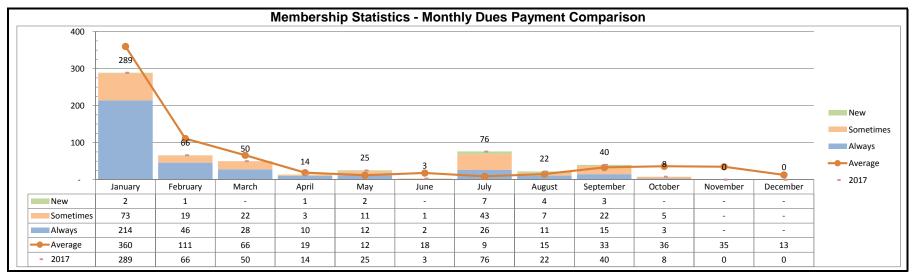

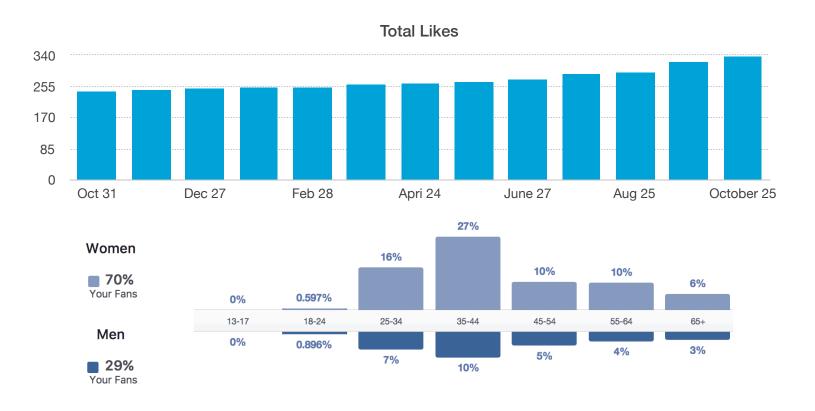

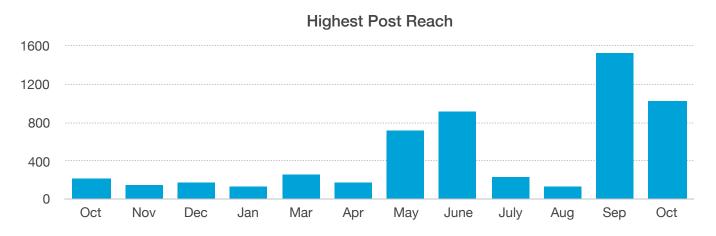
