Block Captain Report (Laura Bradham)

I put out my first feelers to try to recruit a Block Captain for Lillian Joliffe's block, 6502-6614 Cindy Ln with the Thank You Mailings. If anyone knows anyone on that block that might make a good Block Captain, please let me know.

Now that the Coronavirus situation has sort of stabilized, I will begin working with the Block Captains again.

Of Block Captains, 22 have paid dues, 16 have yet to pay dues for this year. I will be emailing Block Captains later this week to fill them in on the mailing that went out and also how the newcomers get their name and email address when they are greeted by Timbergreeters. Lorie Hood, the new Timbergreeter Chair, is emailing Block Captains directly when someone on their block is greeted.

Deed Restriction Enforcement (Traci Riley)

- 2311 Haverhill reported with activity and no DRC approved plan. Contacted number listed on permit and design was received by DRC. Thanked neighbor who emailed for their support.
- two new DRE committee members: Courtnie Hays section 5 and Matt Fleming section 6. Thank you to both of them for stepping up.
- discussions in the works about webpage changes for a stronger call to action with DRC submittal on the deed restrictions page. Stay tuned.

PROGRAMS (Programs)

We have reached out to Abby Kamins office in regard to scheduling her for our September meeting. Leigh Kilgore asked that we include TMNA members as well for a larger draw. To date I have not heard back from the district C office. I'll keep you updated. Any other future speaker suggestions, please send them my way.

Design Review Committee (Dana Whitley)

The plans for 2311 Haverhill Dr were just submitted today. The file was very large and may not have reached all of you. I've taken out the extraneous attachments so that the tile size is reduced to something that may get through to you.

I've done a quick review of the plans. There are no conflicts with the site restrictions or the aesthetics, in my opinion, but they have a 2-story residence. Problem is the Section 14 Deed Restrictions only allow a 1-1/2 story. The rear and sides of the design clearly indicate a second floor wall. Personally I like the design but it is a 2-story residence and does not meet our current definition of what constitutes a 1-1/2 story. I have no option but to deny the approval.

Please take a quick moment to look over the plans and see if you agree with me. I don't want to leave these people hanging especially if the submission is to be denied.

Environmental Affairs (Vacant)

There is a new person to the neighborhood, Avery Beach, who is interested in volunteering with the Environmental Affairs Committee. I've emailed her, hoping she lived on a street for which I needed a Block Captain, but, alas, she does not. She's very interested in getting started.

Membership Report (Laura Bradham)

Let's Do the Numbers

As of April 10, 2020, we had a total of 430 Members, 35% of the neighborhood, based on information given to me from those that have joined by check and those on Square. Last year, by the September 15 cut off for the contest, we had 492 Members, a total of 40% membership of the neighborhood overall. I have captured email addresses for approximately 90% of those that have joined this year.

This week, a Thank You Mailing went out to 421 members! The other members received their Thank Yous at Project Dogway or through the Timbergreeter Campaign described below.

The Timbergreeters had a "Catch-Up" Campaign, and greeted 43 houses since the last time Timbergreeters was fully functional. Of those houses greeted, 5 have taken us up on the complementary membership. Of those 5, 2 have also paid an additional membership for their partner, and 1 has become a Block Captain!

After thinking it through with Miles, I will reinstate the Membership Contest this year, with the twist I mentioned at the Rainbow Lodge when we met there in February. I will be giving wine prizes to the long and short block that have the greatest percentage IMPROVEMENT. This allows for blocks that had low membership to have a fighting chance at winning. Miles ok-ed the idea that any block that has 100%+ improvement in membership rates get 2 bottles of sparkling wine automatically. I'll write an article for the next Timbergram (July) describing the contest and announcing that one block is already in the 100%+ category – 6003-6031 Pineshade Lane!

As of April 10, we have 3 people from Timbergrove Manor Neighborhood Association (the other side of TC Jester) that have incorrectly joined TMCC. I will be writing a letter, putting it in an addressed, stamped envelope, and taking the envelope over to Jenn Wilson's so that when she has time to get a check written, she can include it and mail them a refund. Last year, we only had one person from that neighborhood wrongly join us from what I remember.

Neighborhood Security (Matt Kern)

- Citizens Patrol training to be rescheduled following relaxation of the stay-home order. Gas reimbursements, planned to start in April, will not hit the financials until CP restarts.




