Committee Reports

Block Captain Report (Laura Bradham)

Laura Bdraham emailed each Block Captain to let them know where they stand for the new Membership Contest. At least one Block Captain lit a fire with her neighbors and her block had a big increase this month! Also, several Block Captains have joined TMCC, not realizing they hadn't, but did realize when they saw their address was missing on the list I sent them. And, one Block Captain discovered that her form and check had been lost in the mail when she tried to join in February, so she's joined via Square. So, we are picking up memberships from Block Captains and their blocks!

Laura found out that her Block Captain list was "off" a little functionally when checking on a piece of mail returned to sender. It turns out that the Block Captains for the 6600 & 6700 blocks of Lindyann were dividing up the blocks differently than I had on my list. So, I changed my list to accommodate them as their plan makes more sense! Also had a Block Captain decide to use a different email address. I shared new block division and email address with the Timbergreeters so they can continue to give people the correct information when they start greeting again. I sent a copy of my updated Block Captain List to Miles so that he has the latest information.

Environmental Affairs Report (Peter Davies)

SNC-14 held their June meeting and had speakers from the City of Houston's Floodplain Management Department and Harris County Flood Control District. A number of questions that still remain concerning the development of the Palisades Park to the west of Section 5, which now has four (4) sections and have, or are in the final process of, being platted. During the recent months the contractor has brought in thousands of cubic yards of fill and there were question concerning permits for this activity which falls in both the 100 and 500 year flood plains. A request for copies of the drainage and fill plans have been sent to design engineer, Jones | Carter, but we have not received a response.

Heavy traffic on Shirkemere on Sunday mornings in Section 5 has resumed along with the resumption of services at Grace Bible Church. With the eventual construction of houses in Palisades Park, the Civic Club may need to request additional traffic studies and recommendations to abate the problem including speed cushions on Shirkmere, extension of Ella to Hurst or other traffic measures.

Membership Report (Laura Bradham)

As of June 15, 2020, we have a total of 471 official Members, 38% of the neighborhood. I'm keeping track of how many we had before the membership contest kicked off, and how many join monthly thereafter. I am not anticipating a membership contest next year, and can use these figures to track if the 2 membership contests have been successful, and if so, just how successful. I don't have any raw data of how many members we had yearly, nor how many joined monthly prior to my time as Chair.

Committee Roads Continued

I have captured email addresses for approximately 90% of those that have joined this year, and passed that information on to Cynthia Schwendeman who is working on Mail Chimp for neighborhood emails. I'll be sending her monthly updates when I update my list, already have sent an update to her.

The new Membership Contest kicked off with numbers from May 15! We now have 2 blocks with a 100% increase or better, which will automatically receive 2 bottles of sparkling wine for the NNO party: 6003-6031 Pineshade & 6102-6136 Queenswood. There will be a third one next month when official figures come in after the accountant balances Square. I could tell when I checked my email and saw who joined. I have an article in the Timbergram with the top percentage point increases. This is a fluid number, obviously, but by giving a block 2 bottles of wine when they get to 100% or greater increase moves the ones from the bottom to the top.

Miles and I are working on a letter flyer that the Block Captains can email to their blocks regarding membership. I've written a draft and waiting on Miles to edit. At least 2 Block Captains have created their own and sent them to their blocks.

I've been generating a monthly Membership Roster to share with Leslie and Jenn for Yard of the Month.



Timbergram and Website (Jennifer Vickers)

The July edition of the electronic version of the Timbergram was distributed yesterday to our distribution list of 1,116 recipients. We've had a typical open rate thus far but an increase in the number of readers who are clicking links compared with more recent distributions. Not surprisingly the most popular content is about the Ice Cream Social (Distance). Reports attached, but please note the board update was prepared last week and doesn't reflect the last few days of web traffic. We had 250 visits to the website this week from 239 unique visitors, 72% of which were click throughs from the electronic newsletter.

Also, working with Traci Riley, information about the design review process has been updated on the website and displayed more prominently on the home and about pages.





Daily Traffic Sources




