### **Meeting Minutes**

Meeting Called to Order at 6:30 PM

Video Conference via Zoom

Introduction by Miles Sasser, TMCC President - Welcoming Members

Alex Dailey - Reviewed the "rules of the road" for the Zoom Meeting

### Tonight's Speaker:

Abbie Kamin, Councilmember, District 'C' – Introduced herself, noting this is the first time she has addressed the membership since her election. She spoke about the major issues that are facing her office currently including: COVID19- the economic impact of the pandemic including assistance to small businesses and rent assistance; The Census – The deadline for the census is pending and although the TMCC has a response rate of +/- 52% the City is lagging behind; Food Distribution - Her office has been supporting food distribution and appreciates volunteers from the Timbergrove area; Domestic Violence – There has been an increase of reported domestic violence and her office has been working to increase awareness and communications; Proposed Signage – There is discretionary funds available for signage and the councilmember will provide further information concerning grants to provide signage; Flooding – She told the gathering that tackling flooding is a major priority of her office and has had some success with projects in Turkey Gully area and a drainage study for the area will be completed by the end of 2020 with a presentation possible for TMCC; North Shepherd – Working with the TIRZ there is a major plan to overhaul the corridor adding drainage and mobility improvements; Bryce Street Chemical Feed Station – The councilmember recognized chronic problems and encouraged residents to report foul odors to 3-1-1.

Other issues mentioned following her presentation included the development of Palisades Park resulting in altering drainage patterns and possible fill in the floodplain. Miles recognized the efforts of the SNC-14 in advocating for replacement of concrete panels on West 18<sup>th</sup> Street and the City for following through and doing the work. One further question centered around the deplorable conditions of West 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> Streets and the Councilmember recognized the problem and encouraged residents to send 3-1-1 reports to document the conditions.

The speaker ended their remarks/presentation at about 7:05 PM

### **Officer's Reports**

Secretary's Report – The Meeting Minutes March 10, 2020 were presented. A motion was made by John Zavalla to approve the minutes which was seconded by Traci Riley. As there were no objections to the minutes, the Meeting Minutes were approved without corrections and will be posted to the web site.

Treasurer's Report – The Financial Reports as of September 8th were presented by Miles Sasser and the membership were given the opportunity to question the reports and provide comments. Alison Reynolds made the motion to approve the Financial Statements which was seconded by Chanel Richbourg and approved without corrections as there were no objections.

### **Committee Reports**

Activities – The Board at the August Meeting recommended to cancel the Winter Festival due to restrictions for public gatherings and the City of Houston not issuing permits for Park activities. Neighbor's Night Out may proceed, but may require social distancing measures. The Volunteer dinner is planned to proceed with

Beautification – With Leslie Hillendahl moving out of Timbergrove, TMCC will need a new chairperson; and Miles Sasser expressed the civic club's appreciation of Leslie's years of hard work and dedication.

Block Captains – Laura Braham asked for additional volunteers for portions of Cindy Lane and other volunteer opportunities.

Deed Restrictions – Traci Riley addressed the Membership asking for additional volunteers.

Design Review Committee – Miles Sasser informed members that the Civic Club has been active in reviewing submittals and have been busy with all the additional building going on in Timbergrove.

Environmental Affairs – Chanel Richbourg introduced herself and is looking forward to serving the Civic Club.

Membership - Laura Braham reported that the membership has increased over the past year

Neighborhood Security – Matt Kern let everyone know that the Citizen's Patrol has completed their training with Houston Police Department and began patrolling July 2020. Matt further explained that Citizen's Patrol is separate from Neighborhood Security and is working with eighteen (18) volunteers to patrol. There will be future opportunities for additional volunteers and will provide the required training.

Programs – Traci Riley said that there is a possibility of having the City of Houston present the findings of the drainage report that they have been working on since November 2018.

### **Committee Reports (Continued)**

Timbergram – Alison Reynolds said that the Timbergram has been delivered and requested volunteers for delivery for future editions, with the next one being in November.

Yard of the Month – The Yard of the Month continues to be awarded monthly, however you must be a dues paying member to be eligible.

### Old Business - None

**New Business** - A nominating committee has been formed to provide a slate for next year's Officers and Board of Directors. The committee is headed up by Traci Riley and the voting is scheduled for the January 2021 General Meeting.

There has been complaints about traffic on Ella and Jennifer Vickers made a motion to request a traffic study from the City of Houston for "stop warrant," which was seconded by Traci Riley and approved, as there was no dissent.

There was a Motion to adjourn at 7:51 PM by Jennifer Vickers which was seconded by Alison Reynolds.

The next General Meeting will be November 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 PM.

The arrangements for the General Meeting in January 2021 is pending and will be announced.
